**Every Friday during Lent, Stations of
the Cross will be held at 5:30 pm,
except for Good Friday, when they
will be at 3:00 pm.**

**Abstinence is a penitential practice
consisting of refraining from the
consumption of meat and is observed
by all Catholics who are 14 years of
age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good
Friday and the Fridays during Lent
are days of Abstinence.**

**In addition to abstinence, fasting is to
be observed by all Catholics between
the ages of 18 and 59 years. On Ash
Wednesday and Good Friday, one full
meal is allowed. Two smaller meals,
sufficient to maintain strength, may be
taken according to one's needs, but
together they should not equal
another full meal. Eating between
meals is not permitted, but liquids are
allowed.**

Good Friday, Stations of the Cross,
3:00 pm.**

Easter Sunday, 9:00 am.

Scrutinies, March 11th at Mass and
