**This weekend** we celebrate the Mystery of God, the Holy Trinity. It is a basic doctrine of our faith, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. It reaches us that there are three distinct persons in one God, sharing the same divine nature. Our mind cannot grasp this doctrine which teaches that 1 + 1 = 1, and not 3. But we believe in this mystery because Jesus who is God taught it clearly, the evangelists recorded it, the Fathers of the Church tried to explain it and the Councils of Nicea and Constantinople defined it as a dogma of Christian faith. Each time we make the sign of the cross, reflect on this.
