**TRANSFIGURATION:** Today we hear how God transformed Abram to Abraham as He enters a Covenant with him. Paul argues that it is not observance of the Mosaic Law and Circumcision that transforms people into Christians. In the Gospel Jesus is Transformed. He is seen in His Divine glory, the way we will see Him in heaven. He allows Peter, James and John to see Him transformed, to prepare them when He would be seen in His agony. We prepare to renew our Baptism during Lent, the day we were Transformed.

Last week we began our Parish Lenten Program by reading the book by Matthew Kelly. “Four Signs of Dynamic Catholics.” Last Sunday we shared our thoughts about Prayer. This Sunday, after Mass and coffee, we will meet again to discuss the second chapter, about HOW to pray: Find a place of SILENCE. It is in Silence that God speaks to us. Establish a ROUTINE of prayer: Same time, place and way, every day. Please come and join us on Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings.

Have you taken a Rice Bowl and placed it on your dining table for Lent? Have a Sacrificial meal one day a week and place the equivalent amount in the bowl for the hungry. Let it be your offertory gift on Holy Thursday.

During Lent we celebrate DAILY MASS at 5:30 pm with Rosary at 5:10 pm. On Wednesdays stay for a meager meal, then join a sharing on the “Four Signs of Dynamic Catholics.” (Mass at Murray house this Wed. at 9:30 am).
