Today we begin **HOLY WEEK**. We are invited to take time to reflect on where we are spiritually, who Christ is and what we want from our faith. Please cancel the less important business and come pray together this Holy Week so that on Easter Sunday we may rejoice together. Today we remember our Lord's entrance into Jerusalem to begin his final week walking this earth. Take a palm and hold it for the Blessing, then we will process into the church proclaiming Christ our King. Take the palm home and place it as a reminder that Christ is our King.

MASS on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday will be at 5:30 pm. Come pray the Rosary with us at 5:10 pm. On Wednesday, following the 5:30 pm Mass you are invited to come to the Hall for the SEDER SUPPER. Bring your favorite dish to share with us at the meal that follows. (Sign the list in the vestibule if you plan to come.)

HOLY THURSDAY Mass will be at 5:30 pm followed by ADORATION of the Blessed Sacrament until 10:00 pm. At this Mass we celebrate the First Mass with the Washing of Feet. (We need 12 to sign up for this.) The Offertory Collection will be our Rice Bowl donations. Please sign up for an hour of Adoration after Mass today: 6:30-7:30, 7:30-8:30, 8:30-9:30, 9:30 -10:00 pm.

GOOD FRIDAY is a day of Fasting and Abstinence. STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be at 3:00 pm. LITURGY of Good Friday will be at 5:30 pm: Reading of the Passion, Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. Confessions will be heard after.

HOLY SATURDAY: The Easter Vigil Mass will be at 7:00 pm: Blessing of the Fire and Candle, Procession into the dark church, the Easter Proclamation, Scripture Readings, Renewal of our Baptismal Vows, Eucharist.

EASTER SUNDAY Mass will be at 9:00 am. We are hoping to have organ for Easter.
