The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of our Christian, Catholic Faith. It teaches that there are in ONE God Three distinct and equal Divine Persons sharing the same divine nature. Our minds cannot grasp this doctrine, but we Believe in this Mystery because Jesus taught it clearly, the Gospels recorded it, the Fathers of the Church believed and taught it, and the Councils of Nicea and Constantinople, guided by the Holy Spirit, defined it as a dogma for our faith. Reflect on it each Sunday as we stand to profess our faith.

This weekend we honor Mary, the Mother of Our Lord and our spiritual Mother. We will gather in front of the church before both Masses to Crown the Blessed Mother, sing “O, Mary we crown thee with blossoms today” and process into the church for Mass. Thank you for bringing your children, grandchildren and flowers!

All our Parish Priests will be on Retreat this week, leaving Monday for the Jesuit Retreat house at Convent, La. We will return on Thursday pm. On Monday, Memorial Day, Mass will be at 9:00 am. Next Sunday will be the feast of Corpus Christi. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for our Adoration at 8:00 am, followed by Mass at 9:00 am. Please come to adore the Lord and show your thanks for this Sacrament!

On Friday, May 31, we will pray the Rosary at 5:10 pm, celebrate Mass at 5:30 pm, and have a farewell supper at 6:00 for Fr. Klepac who will retire in late June. Please bring a covered dish.

Saturday, June 1 come to the Ordination to the Diaconate. And on Saturday, June 8, come to the Ordination of 22 Permanent Deacons, including our own, Doug McEnery at 10 am at the Cathedral. A Reception will follow at the Temple on Claiborne Street. And on Sunday, June 9, Deacon McEnery will preach at the 9:00 am Mass. There will be a Reception for him after Mass.
