TITHING AND SCHOOL SUBSIDY

Please be advised that the minimum tithe
to St. Joan of Arc Parish for contributor
tuition rates for Catholic schools is
changing. For 2020-2021 the minimum
will be \$1,350 (\$600 due by 6/1/21 &
\$750 due by 12/1/21). For 2021-2022
and subsequent years, the minimum will
be \$1,500 (\$750 by 6/1/22 & \$750 due
by 12/1/22). If this requirement is not
met we will be unable to subsidize your
child/children attending Catholic
schools. This may result in the school
not offering you the contributor tuition
rate. If this presents a hardship for your
family, please contact Fr. Vrazel.
